Welcome to Jackson County, Alabama!

To help us serve you in the most efficient way please follow these guidelines.

- **DON'T LITTER.** Keep your trash inside your vehicle and dispose of it in a proper manner.
- Residents are required to use the Jackson County issued cans. No other containers will be serviced.
- Cans must be at curb by **5:00 am** on your service day.
- Cans should be on a flat level surface within 2 feet of the roadside and a minimum of 3 feet from any object (mailbox, vehicles, recycling bins, telephone poles, other cans etc.)
- All household garbage should be bagged to prevent spillage and wind scatter.
- All household garbage must be placed in the container. **Do Not Overfill**, this will result in spillage and will be the resident's responsibility to clean it up.
- Due to health-related issues please do not place garbage in any can that is not assigned to you.
- No ashes are allowed in the can, it will burn/melt. If can gets damaged due to ashes, there will be a charge for a replacement.
- Do not have can by an open fire. If can gets burnt or melted, there will be a charge for a replacement.
- No garbage should be placed on top of the can; this will result in spillage. The can will not be serviced.
- To control odor, rinse out the can with water and cleaners such as ammonia or Lysol when needed.
- Residents should remove the can from the roadside in a timely manner.
- In the event of a Holiday, collection schedules will be on the Jackson County Solid Waste Facebook page.
- If you have larger items that will not fit in the can. You may take those items to the Scottsboro Landfill which is located at 650 County Road 412, Hollywood AL 35752.
